The aim of TRAP UP is to create the best possible school life for pupils who are deaf or hard of hearing:

- 1. Develop new materials and concepts for professionals teaching deaf and hard of hearing pupils
- 2. Share knowledge and best practice transnationally within an area of high specialization with few active agents

During the project (2020 - 2023) four new products have been developed:

- Classroom design (D)
- E-learning course for teachers on inclusion (DK)
- Teaching material supporting differentiated teaching (SL)
- Distance teaching technology and didactics (Fi)

All products are adapted into English, Danish, Finnish, German and Slovenian and gathered at a webplatform.

In addition there has been developed an adaption and implementation guide about how to adapt the products into other languages and cultures.
